

The "KalleWirsch" day care centre is a parents' initiative that was established in Biebrich in 1995 as a non-profit association. It is named after a much-loved character from the popular German children's book, "Little King Kalle Wirsch", of which the Augsburger Puppenkiste marionette theatre has also filmed a theatrical adaptation.

Our day care centre enables children aged 15 months to six years to gain a whole wealth of new experiences outside of their family home. We aim to nurture the children's sense of empathy, along with their self-confidence.

The advantage of our small, mixed group comprising a maximum of 18 children is entirely individual, intensive care. The open structure moreover guarantees a constructive dialogue between parents and carers. Allowing us to remain flexible and open to suggestions!





# Are you looking for a day care centre for your child?

Then we would like to wish you a **very warm welcome** to the "KalleWirsch" day care centre located at the heart of Biebrich. We are delighted that you are interested in learning more about our work.

## Our target group

As a single-group facility, we support and supervise a total of 18 children between the ages of 15 months and six years.

## Our parent initiative

We are a non-profit association that was established by a parents' initiative. This means that all of the parents must help out from time to time, too! Parents take it in turn to prepare the children's lunch that the day care staff can then warm up at lunchtime. They also take it in turns to do the laundry. There are shopping duties (food and non-food products) as well as a variety of administrative functions (association board, parents' committee, auditor) for parents to help with.

Care currently costs €250 per month.

## Our guiding principles

We believe it is very important for every child to be accepted as they are and for each and every one of them to be treated as an individual of equal value with equal rights. We provide attentive, respectful care while also fostering the children's individuality.

We support the children emotionally by involving their parents in the initial acclimatisation phase to allow them to quickly settle into our stable community group. We provide reassurance and orientation, and enable them to develop a sense of safety through recurring rituals, routines and fixed daily activities.

## Our developmental activities

We facilitate learning experiences and support according to the guidelines of the Hessian Education and Development Plan. Our developmental activities include:

- early childhood music education
- movement through play and dance
- speech development
- fostering creativity and imagination through visual arts

Given that we do not have our own outdoor facilities, we go to the park here in Biebrich every day or take the bus into town with the children. This allows us to also teach them about road safety.

We hold regular parents' evenings to share details of the children's time at the day care centre with them.

We are aware of our role model function and remain highly committed to the children's education and development.
